1. NEET PG 2020 score sheet / card
2. Duly completed valid print copy of Registration Form of State Medical & Dental PG Seats Allotments 2020, filled on-line.
3. Accepted resignation from the institution in case you are pursuing studies at present or from the college allotted through any other counseling including All India PG counseling
4. Date of Birth Certificate: 10th class certificate / mark sheet or any other equivalent certificate showing the date of birth
5. Mark sheet of 10+2 (senior school certificate examination) or its equivalent
6. Mark sheet(s) and degree / provisional certificate of UG examination
7. Internship completion certificate
8. Attempt certificate of UG examination
9. Photo ID (driving licence / PAN card / Voter ID / Govt. or PSU card / Aadhaar card/ Passport)
10. Domicile certificate (Rajasthan State)
11. Valid Caste certificate, sub-category certificate issued by competent authority (if applicable)
12. Disability certificate issued by disability certificate issued by 11 centers approved by MCC for PG Admissions 2020 (if applicable)
13. Economically Weaker Section certificate issued by competent authority (if applicable)
14. Proof of serving presently in Government of Rajasthan medical services (for in-service candidates)
15. N.O.C. from present employer (if applicable)
16. Any other relevant certificate(s) / document(s)

Note: Candidate must submit OBC NCL / MBC NCL Certificate (clearly indicating 'Non Creamy Layer') / EWS for Rajasthan State issued by competent authority of Rajasthan (issued on or after 18.03.2019).

All the allotments shall be subject to the final decision of DB appeal filed by the State Government.

The candidates are advised to read the notification, seat matrix etc. given on the website, very carefully and also visit the websites regularly.
